

Cable Ready:

Homework: Yes. Four swatches as follows:

Swatch #1: With smooth, light-colored worsted weight yarn, preferably wool, and appropriate-size needles, CO 26 sts.

Row 1 (RS): *P2, K2 . Repeat from * across, ending row with P2.

Row 2: * K2 , P2. Repeat from * across, ending row with K2 .

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 until piece measures approx 1" from beg, ending after WS row. Do not cut yarn. Place sts onto holder.

Swatch #2: With smooth, light-colored worsted weight yarn, preferably wool, and appropriate-size needles, CO 26 sts. Complete same as Swatch #1.

Swatch #3: With smooth, light-colored worsted weight yarn, preferably wool, and appropriate-size needles, CO 15 sts.

Row 1 (RS): *K1, P1. Repeat from * across, ending row with K1.

Row 2: *P1, K1. Repeat from * across, ending row with P1.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 until piece measures approx 1" from beg, ending after WS row. Do not cut yarn. Place sts onto holder.

Swatch #4: With smooth, bright-colored worsted weight yarn (such as red or blue or green; please do NOT use a light color), preferably wool, and appropriate-size needles, CO 22 sts. Complete same as Swatch #1.

Supplies: Homework swatches with yarn still attached; extra white or cream-colored smooth worsted weight yarn; two size 5 double-pointed needles; scissors.

Knitting on the Edge:

Homework: Yes. Five swatches as follows:

Swatch #1: With smooth worsted weight yarn and size 6 knitting needles, CO 15 sts. Work even in Stockinette St for 1". Do not cut yarn. Do not BO. Slip sts to holder.

Swatch #2: With smooth worsted weight yarn and size 8 knitting needles, CO 21 sts.

Row 1 (RS): K 5, make a bobble as follows: [(K 1, yarn over) twice, K 1] all into next st, turn; P 5, turn; K 5, turn; P2tog, P 1, P2tog, turn; slip 1 st knitwise, K2tog, pssol, K 9, make a bobble as before, K 5. Do not cut yarn. Do not BO. Slip sts onto holder.

Swatch #3: With smooth worsted weight yarn and size 8 needles, CO 20 sts. Work even in Stockinette St for 4". Do not cut yarn. Do not BO. Slip sts to holder.

Swatch #4: With smooth worsted weight yarn and size 8 knitting needles, CO 32 sts.

Row 1 (RS): P 3, K 1, (P 2, K 1) three times, P 6, K 1, (P 2, K 1) three times, P 3.

Row 2: K 3, P 1, (K 2, P 1) three times, K 6, P 1, (K 2, P 1) three times, K 3.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 until swatch measures approx 3" from beg, ending after WS row. Do not cut yarn. Slip sts onto holder.

Swatch #5: With smooth worsted weight yarn and size 8 knitting needles, CO 26 sts.

Row 1 (RS): *P2, K10. Repeat from * across, ending row with P2.

Row 2: *K2, P10. Repeat from * across, ending row with K2.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 until swatch measures approx 1" from beg, ending after WS row. Slip sts onto holder.

Supplies: Five homework swatches, smooth worsted weight yarn in light to medium colors; sizes 6, 8, and 10 knitting needles; one size 5 double-pointed knitting needle; cable needle; scissors.

Mosaic Knitting:

Homework: Four swatches pieces as follows:

#1: With smooth, solid light-colored worsted weight yarn and size 8 needles, CO 15 sts. Work K1 P1 rib for 1". Next Row (WS): Purl across. Slip sts onto holder.

#2: With smooth, solid light-colored worsted weight yarn and size 8 needles, CO 23 sts. Work K1 P1 rib for 1". Next Row (WS): Knit across. Slip sts onto holder.

#3: With smooth, solid light-colored worsted weight yarn and size 8 needles, CO 27 sts. Work K1 P1 rib for 1". Next Row (WS): Purl across. Slip sts onto holder.

#4: With smooth, solid light-colored worsted weight yarn and size 8 needles, CO 27 sts. Work K1 P1 rib for 1". Next Row (WS): Knit across. Slip sts onto holder.

Class Materials: Four homework swatches with yarn still attached; a few balls of contrasting brightly-colored (but solid) worsted weight yarn (please do not choose anything too dark); sticky notes (such as Post It™ Notes); size 8 knitting needles; graph paper, 5-squares-to-the-inch; pencil.

Celtic Cables:

Homework: Yes. Three swatches as follows:

Homework Swatch #1: With smooth worsted weight yarn, preferably wool, in a light color and appropriate size knitting needles, CO 15 sts. Work K1 P1 rib for 1", then continue in Stockinette St until swatch measures approx. 2 ½" from beg, ending after WS row. Do not cut yarn. Do not BO. Slip these live sts onto a holder (or better yet, just keep them on your needle for use in class.)

Homework Swatch #2: With smooth worsted weight yarn, preferably wool, in a light color and appropriate size knitting needles, CO 20 sts. Complete same as swatch #1.

Homework Swatch #3: With smooth worsted weight yarn, preferably wool, in a light color and appropriate size knitting needles, CO 36 sts. Complete same as swatch #1.

Supplies:

Four homework swatches with yarn still attached; a few balls of contrasting brightly-colored (but solid) worsted weight yarn (please do not choose anything too dark); sticky notes (such as Post It™ Notes); size 8 knitting needles; graph paper, 5-squares-to-the-inch; pencil.
